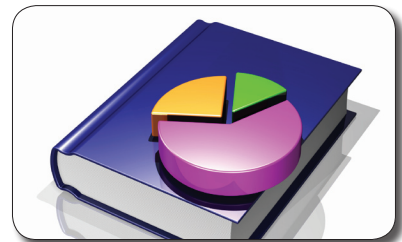

### Assessment

### Multiple capabilities of Pearson LearningStudio ePortfolio:


- **Administrators** can run special reports for re-accreditation, learning outcome management and data analysis.

## Manage Multiple ePortfolios and Processes

- Administrators can run a variety of reports related to both internal and external standards.
- Faculty can have students create assessment-oriented electronic portfolios that align to specific course and program requirements.
- Students can create personal showcases or special presentations and career and employment strategies.
- Users can have administrative capabilities, allowing them to set parameters around how electronic portfolios are shared (access privileges), assessed and/or presented for feedback and peer reviews.
